1. Get a piece of printer paper or poster board



Sketch your poster with a pencil (if you have a lucky pencil, all the better). Try matching the design and drawings to the genre of music your band plays.

- Poster board (optional)
- Pictures of your band (optional)
- Craft glue
- Pencil
- Eraser
- Colored pencils, markers, or paint
- Stickers
- Other poster decorations



3. If you have an anthem like ETM's "You're Never Alone In The Fitness Zone," consider featuring the title of the popular song on your poster.

a. If you want to include a picture of your band, make sure you outline a space for that.



 Print out the Big Nate band cutout sheets and paste whichever cutouts you like on your poster. Add the band picture in this step if you choose.



5. Time to add color and other fun stuff! You can use pencils, markers, paint, letter stickers, glitter star cutouts—anything to jazz up your poster. Think about your band's genre again in this step. If you're a rock band called The Savage Slug, use dark colors and a font that grabs attention.







6. If you're promoting a show, don't forget to write the date, time, and location!
